

The Voucher Program for Patients



With the National Kidney Registry's **Standard Voucher Program**, someone who wants to be your donor can donate a kidney on your behalf, even if they are not a medical match for you.

How it Works

1. Your intended donor **registers with the NKR**. If they are approved, they enter the Voucher Program.
2. The donor is **activated in the NKR system**, and the NKR begins searching for a matching recipient.
3. The **donation takes place**, and the kidney is transplanted into the matching recipient, generating a voucher for you.
4. When you are ready for a transplant, **you redeem the voucher** at an NKR center, and the NKR begins searching its pool of donors for a good match.
5. When a match is found, the **identified donor proceeds with their donation**, and you receive a transplant with their kidney.

Advantages of the Voucher Program



Overcome Compatibility Issues – Your donor does not have to be a medical match for you.



Get a Better Match – Using the Voucher Program can help you get a better-matched kidney for a longer-lasting transplant.



Start the Transplant Process When You Are Ready – You activate your voucher when you are medically ready for a transplant, giving you time to plan and prepare.
